Pennsylvania Residents, 2000

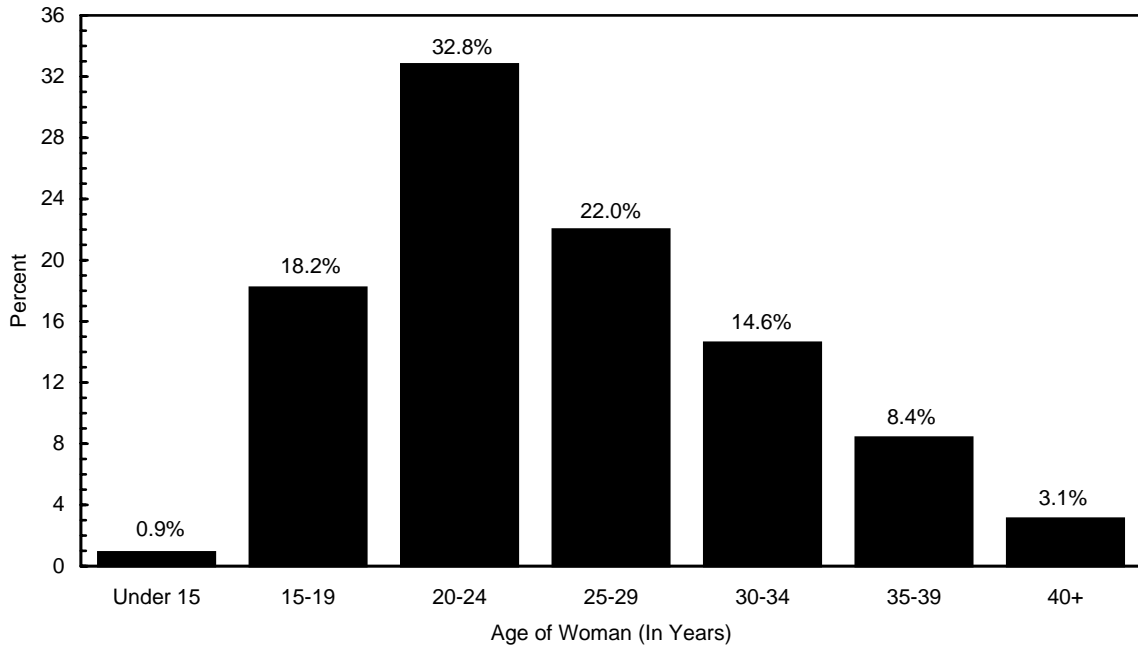

Pennsylvania Residents, 2000

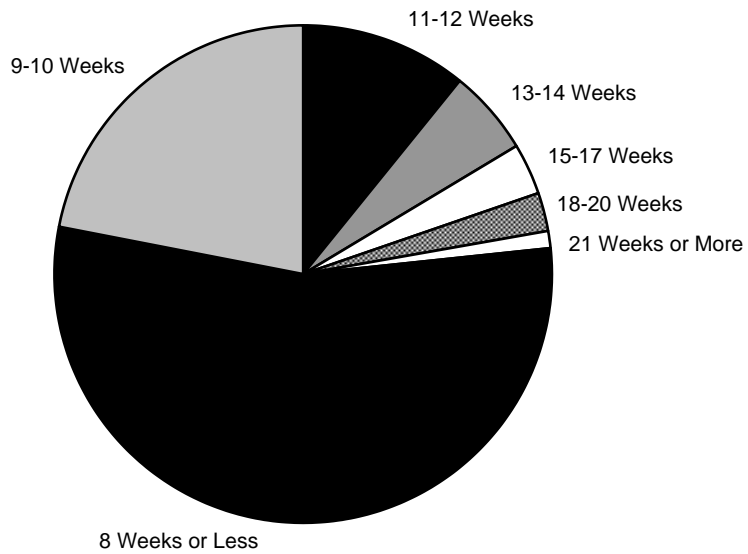
